

Identifying materials found in Maryland Province Addenda (119.1) in the revised Archives of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus (GTM 000119)

Using as an example items found in the Maryland Province Archives Addenda, box 68. The folder number is not known.

1 How do I find materials found in the legacy finding aid for the Maryland Province Archives Addenda now that the finding aid for the collection has now been revised? I am interested in the Procurator Cash and Daybook, c. 1839, that was found in box 68. I do not have the folder number.

2 The old citations are preserved in the identifier number. These numbers were created by shortening the citation to the following format: coll#_box#_folder#.

3 The collection numbers are as follows:

119 -- Archives of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus (GTM 119)

119.1 --Archives of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus addenda (materials accessioned after the completion of the legacy finding aid.)

53 -- Maryland Province Collection (GTM 53)
