Using as an example Maryland Province Archives (GTM 119), box 62, folder 7.

1 How do I find materials found in the legacy finding aid for the Maryland Province Archives (GTM 119) now that the finding aid for the collection has now been revised? I am interested in materials found in box 62, folder 7.

2 The old citations are preserved in the identifier number. These numbers were created by shortening the citation to the following format: coll#_box#_folder#.

3 The collection numbers are as follows:

119 -- Archives of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus (GTM 119)

119.1 --Archives of the Maryland Province of the Society of Jesus addenda (materials accessioned after the completion of the legacy finding aid.






